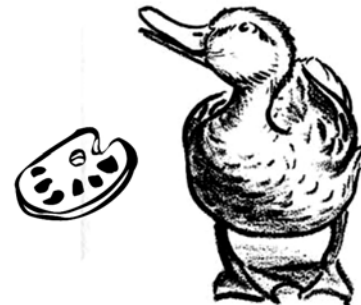
MAKE WAY FOR DUCKLINGS!
